

## **Entry, Stay and Dependant Arrangements**

- Successful applicants will normally be allowed to stay for initially 12 months.
- Subsequent extensions of stay will normally follow the 2-2-3 year pattern.
- You may also bring in your spouse and unmarried dependent children under the age of 18 to Hong Kong. Their length of stay will be linked to that of yours and they are free to take up employment or study during their stay in Hong Kong.
- After seven years of continuous ordinary residence, you may apply for the Hong Kong permanent resident status in accordance with the laws.


